SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

'Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations'

- 1 Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman status rally time trial on Saturday 17 July 2010 at Brougher Mountain, Tempo, Co Fermanagh.
- 2 The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions which the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3 MSA permit number 59556 has been issued for the event.
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd.
- 5 All entrants and drivers must produce a valid competition licence and club membership (National 'B' stage rally or above).
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be as follows:
Scrutiny – Friday 16 July 2010 from 19:00 to 22:00hrs.
Any competitor not signed on by 08:00hrs on Saturday 17 July will be excluded as per R 5.1.1.
NB: The organisers WILL NOT extend this time for any competitor. At scrutiny, cars will be examined for compliance with tyre and vehicle safety regulations as well as for class eligibility. Entrants should have full knowledge of the car as to its eligibility for the class entered. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations J and R 46 –48. A noise test will be carried out prior to vehicle scrutiny as per R 4; maximum limit is 100dBa (as per R 4.1.2).
Convoy run starts at 09:00hrs, First official run starts at 10:00hrs

- 7 The length of the course is approximately 2.4 miles and consists of 12 to 20 feet wide tarmac, concrete and loose surface.
- 8 Starting order will be determined by competition number and class. This will be strictly enforced.
Cars will start in single file and at one minute intervals.
The starting signal will be visual.
The finish line will be indicated by Stage Rally Finish Boards.
Method of timing will be electronically activated digital watches.
Results will be based on a cumulative time – best three out of five runs.
- 9 Competitors will have the opportunity of a convoy run. There will be five official timed runs immediately after the convoy run.
- 10 Competitors will be identified by competition numbers displayed on both sides of the competing car in accordance with J 4.
- 11 The event will consist of 9 classes as follows:
Class 1 – Group N cars up to and including 2000cc
Class 2 – Group N cars over 2000cc
Class 3 – Clubman (Group A and modified) up to 1450cc
Class 4 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1451cc up to 1650cc, not having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 5 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1451cc up to 1650cc having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 6 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1651cc up to 2100cc, not having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 7 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1651cc up to 2100cc, having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 8 – All other eligible cars (R 46 – 48 & appendix 2) including WRCs

Protests regarding class eligibility must be made before the commencement of the first official run.

ALL VEHICLES MUST COMPLY WITH MSA REGULATIONS AND HOLD A VALID MOT CERTIFICATE OR EQUIVALENT (R 46.1.2). ROAD TAX WILL BE REQUIRED AS PER R 46.1.1.

- 12 Awards will be presented as follows:
1st and 2nd overall 4wd
1st and 2nd overall 2wd
1st in each class – trophy
2nd in each class – trophy
3rd in each class – trophy
Ladies Award
Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the organisers.
- 13 The finish venue will be Tempo Community Hall.
The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations on EMC Ltd's website.
The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
The closing date for entries will be Wednesday 7 July 2010.

15 The maximum entry for the meeting is 100. The minimum is 50 and the minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. A competitor will be granted a refund provided the organisers are notified by the competitor of their inability to compete no later than 18:00hrs on Friday 16 July 2010.

17 Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event in Tempo Community Hall in accordance with D 26.1.2.

18 Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C 5.

19 Marking and penalties:

- (a) Jump start – no time recorded
- (b) If all wheels of a car cross a straight line between any 2 markers or otherwise leave the track, no time is recorded (Judge of Fact – all signed-on marshals). In addition, the car shall stop and not proceed until instructed to do so by an official/marshal.
- (c) Any competitor travelling against rally traffic whilst on the track – exclusion.
- (d) During official runs, if any competitor fails to compete in class and number order, they will forfeit that competitive run.
- (e) If any competitor fails to start their run when instructed to do so by an official, no time will be recorded for that run.
- (f) In the event of a tie, the competitor who achieves the fastest time on the first timed run will be judged the winner. If this is not sufficient to resolve the tie, the times of the second, third and fourth timed runs will be taken into consideration.
- (g) Any competitor who practises, reconnoitres or otherwise examines the special stage, or uses any other person(s) to do so on their behalf, will be excluded from the event and reported to the MSA. **This will be strictly enforced.** Members of the organising committee who are setting up the event are exempt from this rule – without their help there would be no event.

20 Any vehicle which fails to complete their timed run and is stopped between the start and finish time controls will be removed from the track by means of a 4 wheel drive vehicle at the sole discretion of the organisers.

21 Final instructions 1 will be available for downloading from EMC Ltd website from 10 July 2010.

22 Competitors are required to supply the name and address of their insurance company on the entry form (A32). MOTOR SPORTS RISK SERVICES. The Club has applied to Motor Sports Risk Services for a blanket cover note under the above scheme. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the third party cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the road section of the event. Please note, the use of this scheme:

- 1 Drivers must be over 21 and have held a full driving licence for at least 6 months
- 2 Not more than 1 fault accident in the last 3 years
- 3 No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence
- 4 No physical or mental disabilities
- 5 No other material facts

All material facts must be disclosed. Material facts are those likely to influence the acceptance or assessment of your risk. Failure to disclose material facts may lead to the insurer declaring the resultant cover to be null and void. If you are able to comply with all the above points, simply sign the 'signing on' form for insurance at documentation scrutiny – **no letter of acceptance needs to be issued.**

If you are unable to comply with any of the above points, insurance must be applied for at least 3 weeks before the event **as a letter of acceptance must be issued.** To do so, complete a declaration form, available from the Event Secretary or Motor Sports Risk Services on 0161 8283300, fax 0161 8283335, or web www.locktonmotorsport.com **NB, if applicable, no letter, no start.** The basic rate for the event (before any loading) is £27.30. This is NOT included in the entry fee.
