SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the club may issue.
2. The event is open to all fully elected members of Peak Performance Motor Club, Autotest Drivers Club, Ballynahinch Motor Club, MG Car Club, M.I.N.I, Police Motor Club NI and Thoroughbred Sports Club.
3. All competitors and passengers must produce a valid membership card.

Signing on and scrutineering 9.30 am
Drivers briefing 11.00 am
First car starts at 11.15am

4. The event will consist of the following class:-

CLASS 1: Juniors (Ages 14 – 16)

CLASS 2: Ladies/Beginners (To have done no more than 5 tests)

CLASS 3: Front Engine FWD, Rear Engine RWD

CLASS 4: Front Engine RWD

CLASS 5: Autotest Specials

5. The maximum entry is 40 and the minimum is 10. If any class is not achieved, the organizers reserve the right to amalgamate classes. The organisers have the right to cancel the event, refuse an entry or re-classify an entrant.
6. All competing cars should be taxed and roadworthy as per M17.1 - 17.3 (MSA Yearbook). All production cars should be standard and not exceed 1400 cc for juniors. The vehicle must be by definition a 'touring car'. **NO HIRED CARS ALLOWED.**
7. **Tyres must be road legal.**
8. **Juniors - One passenger only holding a full RTA licence will be allowed during any test and they must wear a properly fastened seatbelt at all times. Windows to be kept up during the tests.**
8. Competitors are also reminded of noise limits as per MSA Regulations - J5.17.1-8.
9. Details of tests will be issued at signing-on. **PRACTISING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AND**

MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

10. Timing will be by hand held stopwatch to the nearest 0.10 second. The starting signal will be verbal and where possible the order of attempting tests should be numerical.
11. Penalties will be as follows as per MSA Yearbook Table M.7:-
 - A. Striking pylons/cones - 5 seconds.
 - B. Line Fault - 5 seconds.
 - C. Not performing a test correctly - FAIL (fastest time in class + 30 seconds).
12. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their name, car and class all appear on their timecard and that it is kept legible and in fair condition.
13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event, and a copy will be posted on club Website.
14. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulation C.5.1 - 5.7.
15. Entries must be made on official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee of **£20.00 (Peak Performance Members £18.00, Junior members £12.00) and Juniors £15.00**
