Signing on will take place in the Office on the ground floor of the Control Tower, after your car has been through Scrutiny. Please bring your scrutiny sheet with you when signing on.

Drivers who have not previously competed at a 500 MCRI Sprint **MUST** report to the Clerk of Course on arrival.

You are reminded that under MotorsportUK regulation S7.1.5 and S7.1.5.1 appropriate National A speed licences are required. This applies to drivers in classes 8 (a & b) 9, 13, 14 (over 1100cc) and 15. Drivers in these classes who are not in possession of the correct competition licence will not be permitted to start.

Your relevant Club Membership Card **MUST** be produced at signing on (ie 500 MRCI or any MotorsportUK/MSI affiliated club).

Prize giving for each class will be held, after the event, at the base of the control tower..

Please park neatly in the paddock or as directed.

You are reminded that your vehicle **MUST** be fitted with a timing strut in accordance with S 10.9. Failure to comply may result in the vehicle not being timed.

Good luck, have a good day's sport and please leave the circuit clean and tidy.

The 500 MRCI reserve the right to alter, amend or change these Regulations with regard to: Classes, Awards, Laps, Entry Fees, Times and Named Officials.

The 500 MRCI also reserve the right to refuse an entry from any driver who by his actions on any circuit brings, in the opinion of the Club, the sport into disrepute.
