

COMPETITOR INFORMATION BULLETIN

SPEED LICENCES FOR 2018.

Competitors are responsible for ensuring that they are in possession of the correct competition licence for the Class they compete in. Consult the MSA Blue Book Licencing Section (H) and S7. Licence grades will be checked at event sign on.

Certain Classes and cars need a higher grade of Licence, either Speed National A or Speed National A (Open). A brief summary of the ANICC Classes affected are as follows:

- Class 8A / 8B Cars over 1100cc require a Speed National A Licence or recognised equivalent from another discipline unless the car is currently licensed for use on the public highway and competes in a road legal condition
- Class 9 Cars over 1100cc require a Speed National A Licence and cars over 2000cc or 1428cc forced induction require a Speed National A (OPEN) Licence or recognised equivalent from another discipline unless the car is currently licensed for use on the public highway and competes in a road legal condition
- Class 12 Cars over 1100cc require a Speed National A Licence, cars over 2000cc or 1428cc forced induction require a Speed National A (OPEN) Licence or recognised equivalent from another discipline unless the car is currently licensed for use on the public highway and competes in a road legal condition
- Class 13 Speed National A Licence required or recognised equivalent from another discipline (except pre 1994 Formula Ford) for cars over 1100cc
- Class 14 Speed National A Licence required or recognised equivalent from another discipline for cars over 1100cc
- Class 15 Speed National A required up to 2000cc or 1428cc Forced Induction or recognised equivalent from another discipline . Speed National A (OPEN) or recognised equivalent from another discipline required for cars over 2000cc or over 1428cc forced induction.
